WFPS Library fosters positive attitudes towards reading and learning for all students. The library supports the development of literacy, information and technological skills for lifelong learning.

Our school library is a learning and recreational hub situated in the heart of the school, between the lower primary and upper primary classrooms, beside the canteen, technology learning centre, pebble-crete, COLA, and the hall. Student numbers support a Teacher Librarian for 4 days a week (Monday-Thursday) and a Library Technician for 2 hours a week.

Our Library Collection contains approximately 3000 picture books, 1500 junior fiction books, 2500 senior fiction titles, 3000 Information texts, 1500 teacher's resources, Graphic novels, Magazines, Maps, Posters, Audio, 21 iPads, 20 lap tops and an online subscription to World Book Online (Username and password= wfps).



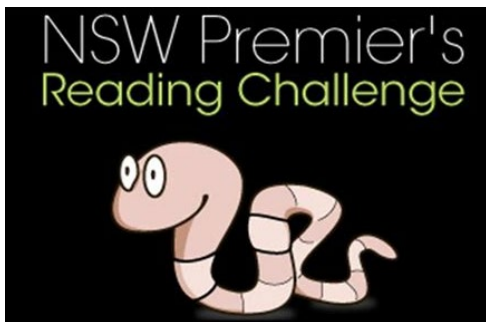

Every year we invite the beautiful pre-schoolers from Wentworth Falls Preschool to join us for the Simultaneous Story-time.
